


Comfort Level to Return to School

Students in Kindergarten through Second grades will either be all on campus (K - 22 students in the Theater with two teachers, and 1st and 2nd in two classes with approximately 12 students with one teacher) when we are allowed to do so, or fully remote when required. Due to the unique learning needs of our youngest students and the importance of giving them a strong foundation on which to build all future learning, we feel that in-person teaching is best for their social, emotional, and academic development. We are not planning on offering a full-time remote learning model or a hybrid for these grades.
